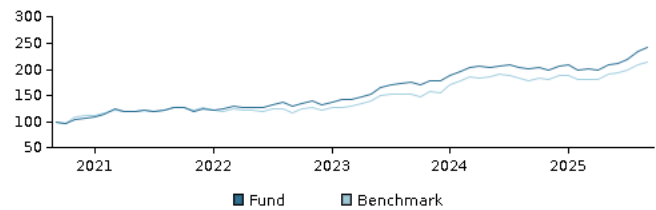
Objectives

Investment policy

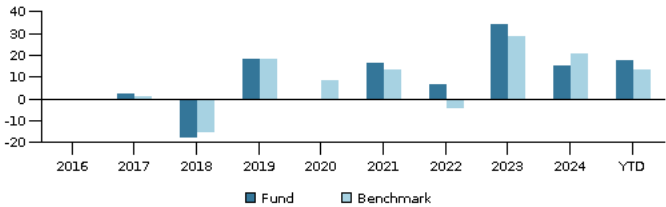
The fund invests mainly in Japanese equities. The fund is categorised as article 8 under SFDR and promotes environmental and/or social characteristics, as well as good governance practices, through screening, exclusions, investment analysis and decision-making as well as active ownership. The fund follows Danske Invest's responsible investment policy. In actively managing the fund's portfolio, the management team selects securities that appear to offer superior investment characteristics. The fund generally expects that its holdings, and therefore its performance, may differ significantly from those of the benchmark. The fund may use derivatives for hedging and efficient portfolio management. Recommendation: This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

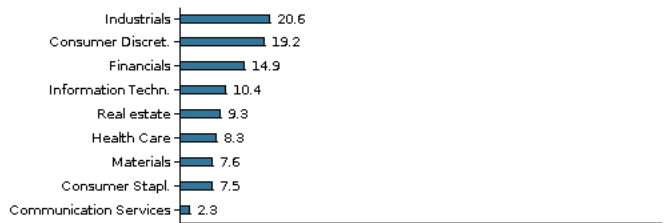
